Acceptable Donations

We can accept:

Doors

- Interior and exterior doors with jambs (frames)
- Solid core door slabs
- Bifold/bypass doors with track/mounting hardware

Furniture and Home Decor

Most Furniture in good saleable condition

(Free of stains, rips, odor, pet hair)

Housewares such as dishes

- Decor such as framed mirrors, Framed artwork, lamps, Silk plants, glassware etc.

Heating and cooling

- Space heaters
- Air conditioners
- Venting, pipe, cover & filters
- Insulation (MUST BE WRAPPED IN PLASTIC)

Appliances

- Air conditioners
- Refrigerators/ Freezers with good compressors and good door seals (please plug in before pick up or deliver upright to avoid damage)
- Microwaves (Built in microwaves only if they have the mounting hardware)
- Washers, Dryers
- Ovens, Range Hoods, Stovetops

Building Material

- Lumber & Trim 6' and longer
- Sheet goods (plywood, OSB, drywall,

- Vinyl and laminate flooring in reusable condition (30 sq. ft. or more per type)
- Engineered and solid wood flooring without glue or nails
- Area rugs

Lighting and Electrical

- **Lighting Fixtures**
- **Ceiling fans**
- **Incandescent and LED light bulbs**
- **Most standard electrical (wire, switches, outlets, conduit, fittings, etc.)**

Plumbing

- Toilets
- Sinks and faucets
- Bath tub/shower surrounds, stalls and pans
- Pipe (6' and greater lengths) and fittings

- Hand tools and power tools
